STATEMENT OF :-

DANESI Angiolana,
114, Poggiali,
Civitella, Arezzo. Female

Who saith,

I am a daughter of the order of S.MARIA
AUSILLATRICE and have lived here for the past year.

About 2000 hours on Wednesday 28 June, 1944,
I met met my brother-in-law, D'ALELIO Attilio aged 47 years,
a resident of LEXHORN who was evacuated from LEXHORN to
AREZZO in February, 1944.

In my presence he expressed his intention of
going to CIVITELLA on the following morning the 29 June, 1944.

About 1200 hours on Thursday 29th June, 1944
in consequence of what I was told I went to CIVITELLA.

I there saw the body of my brother-in-law lay-
ing just outside the town wall near the tower. He had two
bullet wounds, one in the chest and one in the throat.

I assisted in taking his body to his house on
a handcart.

He was buried in the cemetery at CIVITELLA on
Saturday, 1 July, 1944.

My brother brother-in-law was not a Partisan.

I have read over this statement. It is correct
and true. I herewith append my signature.
