Tho saith,

I have lived here all my life with my father MASI lasquale, sixty seven (67) years, mother PONTENANI ROSA fifty one (51) years and brother MASI Luigi, fifteen (15) years.

by mother was nurdered by the Germans on the 29th June, 1944.

On Thursday, 29th June, 1944, I started work at my home about 07.30 hours. About 10.00 hours some children came to my home from MORCAGICIA and told me that the Germans were shooting everyone and burning the houses there. IORCAGICIA is about two (2) bilometres south of CORMIA. I went and told my mother of this but she refused to leave the house. My father was at this time at SLEMA.

I left at once with my brother LUIG: for a wood which is about a hundred (100) metres south of CORNIA. From the time I left my home and when I was in the wood I could hear rifle and machine gun fire which appeared to come from the direction the children mentioned.

About 11.00 hours I could heer rifle and machine gun fire in 00 NIA and later sent the houses burning. I also saw some soldiers who through their dress I took to be Germans. They fore a steel helmet which was camouflaged with trigs, a camouflaged jacket and all were armed. This firing in the village lasted about an hour.

I came out of the wood with my brother and refurned to my home about 15.00 hours. Then I got back my house was berning furiously. There is a stable underneath the house and I saw a pair of legs sticking out of the doorway. Then looked into the stable, I saw my mother's body lying on the floor. A boar pig had been killed also and this was lying on top of my mother but I cannot say why. My mother's body was naked and badly burned from the waist up. There was a bullet wound in her face and several in the head. Her stonach was out and her intestines lying on the floor.

I could still recognise the body as that of my mother despite all these wounds and the burning. The shock of seeing my mother in such a way and my home being on fire was to much for me. I went back to the wood where I remained for that night.

did not return to GRANGA until the British were there. y

/were there. Ly

brother LUFGI assisted by VEMTURINI PIA (now dead) buried the body of my mother on Friday, 30th June, 19/4, in the Eunicipal Cometery at CAMMIA.

I can say nothing of the Germans who killed my nother.

This statement has been read over to me. It is correct and true. I herewith append my signature.
