About 0730 hours, whilst I was working on the ferm I heard rifte fire. This firm appeared to be a kilometre every in the direction of MOMIE SAN SAVINO.

and had no idea what was happoning.

After a while I saw some soldiers who were dressed an though for battle coming up the hill towards my house. These soldiers were too far away for me to recognise or describe in any way; they all were steel believe and carried rifles.

and next my wife who I know by this time would be on her cany back home. I not her about two hundred metres from my home and cold her what I had seen and heard. To decided to go into the wood for a shile. As we were doing this someone fired at us with a machine gun but luckily we were not hit.

We remained in the wood with all was quiet and the firing stopped then returned to our home about 1500 hours. My home had been set on fire so we tried to put out the flames and save whatever we could.

About 1400 hours, ROSSI Caterina, come and told me that all her femily had been killed and were lying in the road. I went to her home and lying in the road I saw eight badies. I examined all the bodies and all appeared to be dead. They all had save a bullet wounds in the head and chest.

I recognised all the bodies. They were to DEL CUCINA Ilva, a girl 11 years, INL CUCINA Elsa, a girl 6 years, DEL CUCINA Gaetane, a boy 14 years, and their father INEL CUCINA Antonio 51 years. Also ANALJOHI Dente, LB years. HARTOVANI Koria, 86 years, Fight Adelmo, a boy 14 years. There was also the body of a man whom I only know as "ANDI" (DI INMAIL HANDI). Its lead only lived here for a short while.

burnt to the ground. /monget the ashes I have the bodies; one of a man and one a momen. Their clothes had been burnt off their bodies out I could recognise them casily.

and his wife MASSIMI Valentina 37 years.

I then helped AMA SOUL Mire to corry all the bodies

fell the bodien

into the house. When I had finished this I went back home to work.

About 1900 hours the same day Lizzerost Settimic came to me home and said her house had bee set fire to by the Germans. She asked me to helpher. I went with her to her home which is about two hundred metres away in the direction of MONTE SAN SAVINO. There was a farmer there when I do not know. As we were standing talking outside the house I heard schoole shouting for help.

I went up to the room from there I had heard the shout and there saw six women lying on the floor. One CARATELLI Palmira, who was severely wounded in the stemen and chest was still alive. She asked to be carried out of the room as it was full of smoke. Between us we managed to get herebut and dressed her wounds as best we could. By the time we finished this it was dark and there was no means of lighting to there was nothing more we could do that night.

The following morning, Friday 30 June 14, about 0700 hours I went back to the farm of CARATELLI. There were a few people there from round about and I halped to get the bodies out of the house. All the bodies had severe bullet wounds in the chest, stomach, and legs. There were five women's bodies and I recognised SESTINI Hosa, SESTINI 1, FICCHIONI Idvia, BURALI Venda, and VALFRI Gira. There were four month SERALI Sabatino, LANGEROWI Pietro, BURALI Tite and the other I do not know.

The rest of that day I assisted in the making of coffine for these bodies.

They were buried that day in a field outside the farmhouse as everyone was afraid to go to the countery in case the Germans were there.

On Sunday 2 July 44, we dut the bodies up and took them to the Runicipal Cemetery at OCRNIA where they were buried. The priest ECN RUNARELLI Natale officiated at the ceresony.

I can may nothing of the Germans as I never saw
