Who saith,

I am the wife of Celso FRATASI, aged 51 years, at present at CAMP "A" CIVILIAN INTERNEE, C.M.F.. We were married in 1927 and up to 1935 we lived at CIGGIANO. In 1935 we went to live at AREZZO, where my husband was employed in the provincial administration.

Charles of the 9th. Pecember, 1943, we motored to GIGGIANO owing to the air raids in ARE 20. About the 18th. June, 1944, from GIGGIANO we motored to my present address at POZZO, commune of FOIANO DELIA CHIANA. The day after our arrival here my husband left stating that he was going to AREZZO, to live at the convent of the DOMINICAN MORES as there was a danger that he would be rounded-up by the Germans or by the Fartisans. He did not return until the evening of the 29th. June, 1944. I can remember this date because it is the feast day of S. PRTER and PAUL. I cannot give an account of the whereabouts of my husband during these ten days, but in his return he told me that he had sheltered at the DOMINICAN CONVENT at AREZZO.

arrested by the Partisens, which was on the 15th. or 16th.
July, 1944, my husband did not leave here.

best of my knowledge he did not commit any act to the detriment of the Allied Forces or the Italian people.
