Who saith,

I am a domestic servant, and up to December 44, I was employed by Signor PAOL Venicio, at the latter's house situated at SAN POERINO, a locality in the hills south west of MONTE SAN SAVINO.

On the morning of 2 July 44, about 0600 hours I went to the fountain to fetch water. On the way I encountered two German soldiers who were escorting a man whom I knew as CARLETTI Luigi, from MONTE SAN SAVINO. I was only able to recognise CARLETTI through my long acquaintance with him, as he was disfigured. His face was black with bruises and he was being supported by his escorts as he was unable to stand by himself. He was wearing a short sleeved summer shirt and corduroy trousers. The bare parts of his arms were also bruised. On seeing him I greeted him, but the soldiers immediately indicated me to go away. I went to get water and then I tried to remain concealed in order to see what was happening. The soldiers, however, discovered me and they chased me, threatening to kill me. I proceeded home and did not see CARLETTI again.

The two soldiers mentioned were dressed in black uniform, without cap, and armed with pistols.

I have read over the above statement. It is correct and true. I herewith append my mark.
