I am a farmer and have lived at my present address all my life.

About 1900 or 2000 hours on the 30th. June, 1944, some fifty German soldiers arrived here in trucks. All told, they had about ten vehicles, among which was a gream coloured FIAT 1100 car.

In arriving one of these soldiers asked me if I was the head of the house-hold, and I said I was. The same soldier then informed me that he was a captain and that he degired a room. He then asked me if I were a fartisan or whether there were any fartisans in the neighbourhood. I said "No". And he reported that there were many fartisans around here, especially at CIVITELIA and SAN FANCHAZIO and that he had been to these two villages and set fire to then an account of the Fartisans.

This officer conversed with me on his own as he made himself understood fairly well in Italian.

These soldiers arrived here with some cattle and they asked me for a stable and they put three calves, ten goese, and three pigs in it.

I noticed that the vehicles which these Gomens had bore a sign consisting of a blue "N" on a white circle.

On the 1st. July, about 1900 hours, all the soldiers left. They left behind at my farm the body of the FIAT 1100 which I have described previously. On the rear of this body is painted a blue "W on a white circle; to the right of this sign there all a right of painted in white.
