I am an estate owner and have lived here since 1943.

About 20 Jun 44, German paratroops started to make their way through this locality, moving in the direction of FLORENCE. Some of these soldiers had transport but a number were making their way on foot and by cycle.

On 30 Jun 44, about 2300 hours, a German General, whom I later knew was General HEIDRICH, arrived and requisitioned my villa. HEIDRICH remained here until 2 Jul 44, when he left at 1700 hours.

The following morning about 1230 hours the first Allied troops came into this area.

I read and understand English perfectly. I have read over this statement. It is true and correct. I herewith append my signature.
